SALVATION

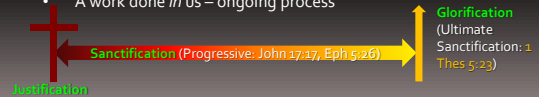
1 Thessalonians 5:23 – May God Himself sanctify you: spirit, soul and body.

Justification: occurs in the spirit of man

- Removes the **guilt** and **penalty** of sin
- An act done *for us* – once and **final**
 - Eph 1:13,14 & 1 Cor 1:22

Sanctification: occurs in the soul (mind, will, emotions) of man

- Removes the **growth** and **power** of sin
- A work done *in us* – ongoing process

Sanctification

Knowing 6:3-10	Counting 6:11	Presenting 6:12-14, 19	Obeying 6:15-18
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1. v. 6 – We were crucified with Christ (Death)
 - Our body of sin was done away with!
 - We are no longer slaves to sin!
2. v. 9 – We have been resurrected with Christ (Life)
 - We have His life now living in us!
 - We too might walk in newness of life (v. 4)

Sanctification

Knowing 6:3-10	Counting 6:11	Presenting 6:12-14, 19	Obeying 6:15-18
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Where faith drops out, LOGIZOMAI is present.

LOGIZOMAI (λογίζομαι) log-id-zom-ah-ee

- “Consider” “Reckon” “Credited” “Numbered” “Account”
- “to count as fact”; “to make a mental calculation”
- If I put 1000 dollars in my bank account, I have 1000 dollars in my bank account, from which I can make draws.

PRESENTING

Romans 6:12,13 – Present yourselves to God!

- PARISTEMI (παριστημι) – used five times in this section
 - Present, offer, yield.
 - to place at one’s disposal, to present, to offer as a sacrifice
- What does it mean to present ourselves to God?
 - To give myself wholly to God – Lord, I’m fully yours!
- What are we to present to God?
 - Ourselves, but what part of ourselves?
 - Not the “old man” or the fleshly man with his instincts and resources, his natural wisdom, strengths.
 - But the “new man” or resurrected man, or the 2 Corinthians 5:17 man.


PRESENTING

Romans 6:12,13 – Present yourselves to God!

- v. 13 – “as those alive from the dead”
- What died with Christ?
 - All that was of Adam – the old man, the old creation, the fleshly me
- What now is alive from the dead?
 - The new life of Christ in me

Knowing → Counting → Presenting



- Presenting myself to God then means that from the moment of my resurrection on, I am to consider my life and members as belonging exclusively to Him!
- What I present is my new life, nothing of the old creation.

We have been set free in order to reflect the beauty of our Lord, not for our intended purposes.

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Romans 6:19 – Present, resulting in sanctification!

- v. 13 – “as those alive from the dead”
- Holiness does not arise from the eradication of something evil within.
- True Holiness – something or someone becomes holy by being separated for God’s intended use!.
- We are Holy Saints because we have been separated of our old nature and are now reserved exclusively to the Lord!

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Romans 6:19 – Present, resulting in sanctification!

- This is the natural order of my maturity in faith (looking away unto Jesus):
 - I *know* by faith.
 - I *count* by faith.
 - I *present* by faith.
