







## IN CHRIST Our inheritance from Adam (being in Adam): Rom 3:9-20: God as Judge (verses 10 to 12): No one is righteous (of value) in God's sight No one understands anything concerning God No one seeks for God (1 Cor. 10:20) All have turned aside (turned away) And thus, have become useless (unprofitable) No one does good, not even one!

## IN CHRIST Our inheritance from Adam (being in Adam): Rom 3:9-20: God as a Physician (verses 13 to 15): 7. Their throat is an open grave (As Bishop Howe says: "Emitting the noisome exhalations of a putrid heart.") 8. With their tongues they continually deceive 9. They are poisonous just below the surface 10. Their mouths are full of cursing and bitterness (wrong someone) 11. Their feet run to violence

## INCHRIST

Our inheritance from Adam (being in Adam):

- Rom 3:9-20:
  - God as a Divine Historian (verses 16 to 18):
  - 12. Destruction and misery are in their paths
  - 13. They do not know how to find peace
  - 14. There is no fear of God in them

Summary: Total depravity – humanity, apart from God, is dead.

- Eph 2:1 "you were dead in your trespasses and sins"
- Rom 6:23 "for the wages of sin is death"

## **IN CHRIST**

Our inheritance from Adam (being in Adam):

- We received our sinful nature by birth
- We are in Adam by birth.
- Rom 5:17 "by the transgression of the one"

What then is the answer?

- If my problem then is being found in Adam, how do I get out of my Adamness?
  - 1 Cor 15:21-22 "For as in Adam all die"
- I came in through birth, I can only get out through death!
  - 1 Cor 15:45-47 "the last Adam"
