
Renaissance (14th–17th) – *humanism reigns*

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The importance of biblical faith.

- **Rom 5:1** – “having been justified by faith”
- **Eph 2:8,9** – “saved through faith”
- **Heb 11:6** – “without faith it is impossible to please God”

What is biblical faith?

- Wishful thinking?
- Hope against all hope?
- Believing the impossible?
- Believing that which is contrary to fact?
- Believing that which is contrary to evidence?
- Ignoring or blind to reality?

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Ephesians 6:16 – the shield of *faith*

- “Taking” – a continually active thing.

Habakkuk 2:4 – “the righteous will live by his faith”

- **Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:1, Hebrews 10:38**

The Righteous	Shall Live	By Faith
Romans	Ephesians	Hebrews

Hebrews 11:6 – “without *faith* it is impossible to please God”

Whatever “*faith*” is, it is what the disciple of Christ is to live by, so we’d better have a solid understanding of it if we are going to find life that leads to abundancy.

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What is biblical faith?

- **Rom 10:17** – “faith comes from ...”
- Faith comes from hearing – literally with our ears.
- Hearing what?
- “the word of Christ”
 - “word” here is *rhema (rhema)* – specific words or sayings; a declaration of one’s mind made in words.
 - that which is or has been uttered by the living voice, a thing spoken, a word; a series of words joined together into a sentence (**John 3:34**)
- Faith then is directly related to the sayings of and about Jesus.
- Where then do we find these sayings?
 - The Scriptures!

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Hebrews 11:1 – “Now faith is...”

- the assurance.
 - a declaration intended to give confidence; promise; guaranty; surety; full confidence; freedom from doubt; certainty; freedom from timidity; boldness.
 - There is a reality of faith which satisfies the intellect because it is founded on reason – historically accurate and scientifically sound! – **intellectual**
 - Romans 10:17** – “faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ”
 - Faith is based firmly on Jesus as Truth and His Words as the foundation of the way things really are.
 - 1 Corinthians 15:1-8**

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Hebrews 11:1 – “Now faith is...”

- the conviction of things unseen .
 - a fixed or firm belief.
 - Because faith stands on what is demonstrably true, then when I am asked to believe what I cannot verify, I know the demands of me are consistent with what is true.
 - Romans 5:9** – “having been justified by His blood”
 - This reality of faith demands that I surrender my will and believe to be true what I can’t understand or substantiate through history or science – **volitional**.

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The Great Warning concerning faith:

- Hebrews 4:2** – “did not profit them”
 - If Truth does not move one from mere belief to active faith, then it is of no benefit whatsoever.
 - Inactive faith is merely belief. (**James 2:14-26**)

John 20:28 – “my Lord and my God”

- “my God” – proof of intellectual faith
- “my Lord” – proof of volitional faith

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


- Hebrews 12:1,2** – “let us...”
 - “the author ... of faith”
 - Pioneer, Trailblazer, Captain!
 - He blazed a trail for our *justification* before a Holy God!
 - “the perfecter of faith”
 - It is now Him at work in us (**2 Tim 1:12**) to complete us – *sanctification*.

“Faith is not in itself a meritorious act; the merit is in the One toward Whom it is directed. Author: Looking away unto Christ for my justification (spirit)

Perfecter: Looking away unto Christ for my sanctification (soul)

Finisher: Looking away unto Christ for my glorification (body)
